Service Commitment	 2-year minimum service commitment for 1-2 years of scholarship support (full-time status) 1-year additional service commitment per scholarship year for full-time students Work part-time (16 to 31 hours per week) or full-time (32 hours per week or more) with a minimum of 80% of hours dedicated to direct patient care for at least 45 weeks per year. Part-time work extends the length of service.
